During the festival, tickets for all screenings are available at any festival venue during operating hours.

ENHANCE YOUR FESTIVAL EXPERIENCE WITH A DOC NYC PASS:

The All Access Pass for \$750 gives audiences a chance to explore the full range of the festival's expansive offerings, including all films and panels.

The DOC NYC PRO Pass for \$350 provides access to the eight-day lineup of panels and events with leading industry figures, along with daily Breakfasts and Happy Hours, as well as access to the PRO Lounge. A First Half or Second Half PRO Pass offers the same benefits for a four-day period—November 9-12 or 13-16, respectively—for \$200.

DOC NYC PRO Day Passes for \$75 are available for each of the eight days of DOC NYC PRO. Day Pass holders will be guaranteed admission to that day's PRO events, including the Breakfast, Happy Hour and access to the PRO Lounge.

The Viewfinders Pass provides 8 admissions to screenings in the Viewfinders Competition, plus a weekend coffee hour with filmmakers and festival programmers, for \$99.

A Ten-Ticket Package gives moviegoers 10 tickets to festival screenings (excluding Opening and Closing Night) at a discounted price of \$160.
